We are also making our Employee Assistance Program (EAP), LifeWorks by Ceridian, available to all Blue Cross Blue Shield of Massachusetts members who may need support or assistance in coping with the effects of the last week's Boston Marathon Tragedy. These resources will be at no cost to the members and will include 24-hour access to behavioral health consultants for clinical assessment, and referrals to community and online resources.
